Feast of Tabernacles 2012
September 27th to October 5th 2012

The Theme for the 2012 Feast of Tabernacles is “The Spirit of grace and supplication” (Zechariah 12:10). The 2012 “Feast” will be held from Sunday September 30th to Thursday October 4th. If you have never had the opportunity to participate in the “Feast” before you are in for a treat. There is outstanding Praise and Worship led by superb musicians from across the globe coupled with wonderful Biblical teaching from internationally renowned speakers. The “Feast” is spectacular and includes brilliant stage performances by amazing dancers in very colourful costumes.

Our group will leave from Luton Airport on Thursday 27th September for our EasyJet Flight to Tel Aviv.

We arrive two days before the Feast begins and we have the great opportunity to join two wonderful optional tours which I have arranged for the UK Group. On these tours we will be accompanied by a fully licensed guide and we will be driven in air conditioned transport. The tours include all admission fees but lunches will be extra:-

Tour 1: We set off from our hotel for the Mount of Olives and enjoy a wonderful day in the vicinity of Jerusalem visiting the Garden of Gethsemane, the Church of all Nations, the Western Wall, the Davidson Centre and the Southern Steps of the Temple Mount. In the afternoon we will enjoy the sights, smells and sounds of the Old City. Additional Cost if you choose to enjoy this tour is £56

Tour 2: An early morning start will take us north to the wonderful region of Galilee, we will drive straight to Ginnosar and see the 2000 year old “Jesus Boat” and from there we will enjoy a sail on the lake in a replica of the boats from the time of Jesus. For lunch you may wish to enjoy St Peter’s Fish (additional charge) and afterwards we will visit several of the sites around Galilee including Capernaum and the Mount of Beatitudes. On this tour you will walk in the footsteps of Jesus. Additional Cost if you choose to enjoy this tour is £95.

Our accommodation in Jerusalem is the excellent Ramada Hotel where you will enjoy 5 star facilities. The hotel has superb dining facilities an indoor and outdoor pool and a fitness room plus much more. I have stayed there several times and commend it to you. The hotel is within a fifteen minute walk of the International Convention Centre.

There is a very new tram system with a stop close to our hotel and the tram will take you down to the Old City or the great shopping area around Ben Yehuda Street. My wife Marion and I will be happy to advise you and for those who are reasonably fit you may enjoy a walk through Jerusalem to some of these wonderfully evocative sites.

Highlights of the Feast will include:

- *Sunday 30th September - the Desert Celebration at the Ein Gedi Spa or somewhere nearby when we will enjoy a BBQ, amazing praise and worship and an internationally renowned speaker.*
- *Monday 1st October is a Holy Day but there will be activities going on around Jerusalem and you will be able to choose which you would like to go to. The evening celebration will be in the Convention Centre.*
- *The Parade of Nations*
- *Communion Service*
- *Israeli Night*
- *Participants are invited to take part in the Annual Jerusalem March*
- *Four evening sessions at the International Convention Centre*
- *Tuesday 2nd to Thursday 4th October superb teaching during the morning sessions at the International Convention Centre*
- *Friday 5th October morning at leisure and we will leave our hotel around 3pm for Ben Gurion Airport and our flight home.*

Registration fees at the time of writing have not been fixed last year they were \$435 per adult, \$155 per youth (ages 6 to 16), and children 5 and under were free. There was also an additional charge of \$20 per person for the coach to Ein Gedi. There is a fun filled programme led by AJ the friendly lion for children 12 and under.

The fees for this year will be confirmed in due course. These fees will be collected in advance of the tour by Wendy Hogarth at the ICEJ UK office. As soon as the fees for 2012 are known they will be published and we will obtain a sterling equivalent before you have to pay.

I do hope you can join us and look forward to seeing you at the "Feast" in Jerusalem!
